October Summary: Many thanks to all who helped with October's Kiwanis projects, including Roadside Cleanup, the Apple Sale and Head Start Reading. It takes all of us to make these projects succeed, but special thanks go to Steve Poethke and Steve Shervey for coordinating these projects.

November Meeting Notes (These are NOT official minutes)

The following topics were discussed at the November Board and General Club meeting: No action was taken at the Board meeting due to lack of quorum. No secretary's report, due to secretary's absence. At the general club meeting, the treasurer's report was presented and accepted. Dennis Holtegaard submitted his resignation, and it was accepted. A motion to donate \$50 to Rice Lake Youth Bowling passed (money to come from undesignated funds). There was much discussion regarding this year's apple sale. Expected net is \$900, which is short of budget. This is due to several logistical difficulties (especially with the orchard). A new orchard is being strongly considered for next year's sale. Steve has requested a co-chair or two. The Mayor of Rice Lake contacted club president Steve Poethke to promote a request that Kiwanis, as a community service club, consider donating financially toward rehabilitation of the building at Nora Cemetery. The club declined that request as not fitting within our mission. There was discussion that we need to start planning this year's Kiwanis Christmas party. Anyone who would like to help in this area, please contact Steve Poethke. If you have ideas for the party (where, when or how) please let Steve know, or be prepared to discuss them at the Club Meeting November 10. Winner of the monthly drawing was Steve Shervey, who donated his winnings to the Head Start Book Giveaway.
